ATM FOR WIMMERA BASE HOSPITAL

The Bendigo Bank has installed an automatic teller machine at Wimmera base hospital.

The ATM was launched at a special afternoon tea at Wimmera Health Care Group on Tuesday.

Chief executive Chris Scott said that a number of staff had identified the value of having an ATM at the hospital through their annual employee satisfaction survey more than 12 months ago.
