### **20 YEAR REUNION FOR MURRAY TO MOYNE TEAM**

Wimmera Health Care Group's Woody's Murray to Moyne cycle relay team is celebrating its 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary with a special reunion dinner next month.

The dinner will be held on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> April in Horsham at the Grains Innovation Park.

Kerryn Prouse, rider and organising committee member, said that she was looking forward to reminiscing with old team-mates. "I've been involved with the Woody's Murray to Moyne cycle relay team for 18 years now and I've met some fantastic people along the way" she said.

"We've sent out expressions of interest to many of the people involved over the past 20 years, but we've lost touch with some people and don't know how to contact them" she said.

"If people have had an involvement and haven't received a letter from us, we want to hear from them as soon as possible so that we can fill them in on what's happening."

Mrs Prouse said that the reunion promised to be a great night out. "We've always had a close-knit team. I'm sure we'll share lots of stories and lots of laughs. We'll have photos and other memorabilia on hand too" she said.

The Woody's Murray to Moyne Cycle Relay is a 24-hour cycle relay from Mildura to Port Fairy covering 520 kilometres. Last year, there were 1,435 riders representing 150 organisations, that raised a massive \$1.25 million for regional health services. It is a major fundraising event for Wimmera Health Care Group. Last year, the team raised more than \$15,000 to purchase an inflatable lifting and transferring device for the Horsham campus.
